I, EDWARD HENRY CORBOULD of 7 Trebovir Road Earls Court South Kensington in the county of London Artist hereby revoke all wills and testamentary dispositions heretofore made by me and declare this to be my last will I have had much to do with the Members of the Royal Family since the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty one and have invariably received very great kindness through them I respectfully desire that Her Majesty should deign to accept after my decease the best water colour painting (of recent years) in my possession entitled "The Death of Tursitan the Leader of the Norman Band in Beverley Minster" This desire but faintly conveys an idea of the estimation in which I have ever held the favours which I feel I have but ill deserved The success which has attended my artistic career I attribute entirely to the encouragement afforded me by that Great Prince who was taken from us in December one thousand eight

hundred and sixty one The kind attention of the Queen and Princesses to my late wife
(the mother of my two sons Ridley Edward Arthur Lamothe Corbould and Victor Albert Louis
Corbould) at Osborne and Balmoral was something to be proud of and never to be forgotten
whilst life lasted I bequeath to my son Victor Albert Louis Edward Corbould all my other
pictures prints engravings gold medals carved oak furniture silver articles and objects
d' art He will no doubt give at his discretion one or more of these to such members of
the family as will appreciate them I bequeath to my wife Annie Mellis Corbould all my
furniture and household effects except as aforesaid I devise and bequeath all the rest
and residue of my estate and effects unto and equally between my wife and such of my
children as may survive me And I appoint my said son Victor Albert Louis Edward Corbould
and my friend Thomas Bulstrode Edwardes late of 87 Queens Gate in the county of London
to be the EXECUTORS of this my will And I appoint my said son Victor Albert Louis Edward
Corbould as joint Guardian with my wife of my infant son Pelham Stewart Corbould IN
WITNESS whereof I have to this my will hereunder set my hand the twentieth day of April
one thousand nine hundred - EDWARD HENRY CORBOULD - SIGNED and acknowledged
by the testator Edward Henry Corbould as and for his last will in the joint presence
