

## SECTION XII.

## CORBOULD OF BROOKE.

THOMAS CORBOULD, of Bracon Ash, Norfolk and ? Gray's Inn, London, yeoman, b. 1630, d. 1 Feb. 1709. Married in 1667, ELIZABETH (? GOWER), b. 1639, d. 1713. Both are buried at Bracon Ash.

MATTHEW CORBOULD, d. 24 Oct. 1698, bur. at Brooke.

JOHN CORBOULD, believed to be the son of John and Bridget of Bildeston (see previous page), died in 1693, and was buried at Brooke. He had issue:—

JOHN CORBOULD, of Brooke, Norfolk, 3rd son of John and Honour, was born in 1688, d. at Brooke 14 Dec. 1766, bur. there. Married 1st Mary . . ., who d. circa 1730 and was buried at Brooke. He married 2ndly, at Norwich Cathedral, 1 June 1736, Sarah Copping, of Wymondham, widow. By his first wife he had:—

Francis Corbould of Brooke and Kirstead, both in Norfolk, 6th son of John and Honour, bapt. at Brooke 8 May 1699, d. 1745. Will dated 27 March 1745 (Norwich); Mrs. C., the widow, Rev. John Leman of Kirstead and Saml. Caley of Berghampton, executors. He married Mary..., and had:—

  - 1a. Margery Wilmot, d. at Exeter in 1829. Administration, Exeter, April 1829. Married Prowde Longdill, of St. Botolph, Aldgate, London, master and owner of a ship, who died in 1829, having had:

    - 2b. PYNSON WILMOT LONGDILL, solicitor, Gray's Inn Road, London, legatee under the will of John Corbould the Merchant. Died 1 May 1823. Married ? Selina . . ., and had:—
      - 1c. Selina Longdill, of 36, Belgrave Road, St. John's Wood, Middlesex, d. there 27 March 1876 aged 66. Administration granted 14 Aug. 1876.
      - 2c. Pynson Longdill, merchant, m., 26 June 1852, HARRIET, dau. of George Blackiston Robinson, Esq.
      - 3c. Mary Adelle Longdill, living in 1876, m. Frederic Pfeffel, a merchant, of Frankfort, and had 8 children.
      - 4c. EMILY LONGDILL, living in 1829, m. a retired Austrian officer.
      - 5c. Lieut. Edward Benjamin Longdill, 24th Madras Native Infantry, d. unm. in India 1851 or 1852.
    - 3b. Benjamin Prowde Longdill, of 35, Essex Street, St. Clement Danes, Strand, London, and p. of St. Sidwell, Exeter, surgeon, H.E.I.C.S., d.s.p. at Exeter in 1829. Married his cousin Elizabeth Charlotte Wilmot, q.v.
  - 2a. John Wilmot, solicitor, London. Married (?Elizabeth) Wilmore,\* of Halesowen, Worcestershire, and had:—
    - 1b. ELIZABETH CHARLOTTE WILMOT, d.s.p. at Uxbridge in 1852 aged 74. Married her cousin Dr. BENJAMIN PROWDE LONGDILL.

\*Thomas Wilmer, Esq., of Dudley, married Martha, seventh daughter of Edward Sutton, 9th Lord Dudley, and had a daughter Elizabeth, who married Gilbert Jellians, gent., of Dudley, and they had a daughter Martha, who married, 15 May 1682, Pynson Wilmot, gent., of Lower Mitton, co. Worcester.

- 3a. Robert Wilmot, partner in the firm of Corbould and Wilmot, 8, Dove Lane, Norwich, married Margaret Martin, of Norwich, and had:—
  - 1b. ROBERT CORBOULD WILMOT, partner in the firm of Corbould and Wilmot, 8, Dove Lane, Norwich. Died unmarried.
- 4a. Dr. Samuel Wilmot, a surgeon, b. at Norwich in 1751, d. at Datchet, Bucks, 1825, Will pr. in Jan. 1826. Married Martha Russell, who d. at Exeter in 1840 aged 78, having had:—
