



With some fearefull and vnnaturall rebuihons hath his Countie of Northfolke bene afflicted the first commenced by John Aulphre a true and sturrowd cutting knygth kynge of the Countee whiche led fiftie thousand Souldiers into the field, and forerably carried the Lord Marley and Scodes to force him at his table with other knyghts, but was lightly overcomen by Henry the first haly of Norwold and worthily hangyd A.D. 1381.

The other was vnder the leading of Robert Kex Tannour of Wymouth, who in a crafte forced the Lord William Bore, a knyght of Northfolke to fight, and tove the Lord Skiffold in the field, but after many dayes came to the Caste of Norwold, which was taken by John Dudley, Carle of Norwold having ffraye therewith of his followers, flame and bright hangyd upon the eye of the crafte.
